NOTICE OF OBJECTION BY MFC INDUSTRIAL LTD TO THE MOTION FOR DIRECTIONS AND THE ISSUANCE OF A SAFEGUARD ORDER (paragraph 57 of the Wabush Initial Order)

TO THE HONORABLE JUSTICE STEPHEN W. HAMILTON, J.S.C. OF THE SUPERIOR COURT SITTING IN THE COMMERCIAL DIVISION FOR THE DISTRICT OF MONTREAL, THE OBJECTING PARTY, MFC INDUSTRIAL LTD. RESPECTFULLY SUBMITS:

- 1. MFC Industrial Ltd ("**MFC**") files this Notice of Objection regarding The Wabush CCAA Parties' *Motion for Directions and the Issuance of a Safeguard Order,* dated November 24, 2015 (the "**Motion**");
- 2. The purpose of this Notice of Objection is simply to confirm that MFC intends to contest the Motion and will make representations to the Court to the effect that the Motion should be postponed in order to allow MFC to prepare a full contestation of the Motion both on the Safeguard Order and

with regards to the Directions or rather Declaration sought regarding the interpretation of the terms of the Wabush Sub-Lease regarding payment of the Minimum Royalty;

- 3. Furthermore, MFC intends to serve an application requesting a partial lift of the stay of proceedings in order to allow for the presentation of a Motion seeking an order of the Court terminating the Wabush Sub-Lease;
- Given MFC's eventual application there is no necessity for the Court to issue a Safeguard order as its intervention is sought to declare the Wabush sub-lease terminated;
- 5. The issues raised in the Motion will necessitate consultation with various parties, document discovery as to historical records, old reports, assays etc. re iron ore reserves, the preparation of witnesses and/or the filing of detailed affidavits and possibly experts reports which it is not possible to determine at what point they can be available;
- 6. A detailed written contestation of the Motion shall be filed in due course in accordance with a timetable of proceedings to be agreed to with counsel for the Wabush CCAA parties and the Court;
- 7. MFC contends that both the Motion and MFC's eventual application regarding the sub-lease should be heard together and a subsequent date to be agreed to between the parties en the Court;
- 8. The filing of the Notice of Objection is contemplated by paragraph 57 of the Wabush Initial Order;
- 9. MFC reserves its rights to make further representations and to raise additional arguments at the hearing of the Motion;

FOR THE REASONS SET FORTH ABOVE, MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT TO:

RECEIVE this Notice of Objection;

POSTPONE the hearing of the Motion for Directions and the Issuance of a Safeguard Order to a date to be determined by the Court.

ALLOW MFC Industrial Ltd. to file a detailed contestation at a later date to be determined and make verbal representations regarding the presentation and hearing of Petitioners' Motion;

THE WHOLE with costs;
