(collectively, the "Priszm Entities") for an order authorizing and approving the Sales Process (as defined below) *nunc pro tunc*, and approving the Genuity Engagement Letter (as defined below) *nunc pro tunc*, and certain ancillary relief was heard this day at 330 University Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

ON READING the Affidavit of Deborah Papernick sworn May 24, 2011 (the "**Sales Process Affidavit**") and the Second Report of FTI Consulting Canada Inc., in its capacity as the Court-appointed monitor of the Priszm Entities (the "**Monitor**"), and on hearing the submissions of counsel for the Priszm Entities, the Monitor, Prudential

Investment Management, Inc. ("Prudential"), Yum! Restaurants International (Canada) Company; Scott's Real Estate Investment Trust, SR Operating Trust, Scott's Real Estate Limited Partnership, Scott's Trustee Corp. and Scott's GP Trust; The Cadillac Fairview Corporation Limited; 20 VIC Management Inc., Ivanhoe Cambridge Inc., Morguard Investments Limited, Retrocom Mid-Market REIT, Primaris Retail Real Estate Investment Trust and Oxford Properties Group Inc.; 2279549 Ontario Inc. and Deborah CAW-Canade; Papernick; Otymel; Sysco Canada and Metro-Richelieu Inc., no one appearing for any other person on the Service List, although properly served as appears from the affidavit of service, filed:

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that, if necessary, the time for service of the Notice of Motion and the Motion Record is hereby abridged so that this motion is properly returnable today and hereby dispenses with further service thereof.

hereby approved *nunc pro tunc*, and the Priszm Entities are authorized and directed to perform their obligations under and make the payments contemplated by the

Engagement Letter.

5. THIS COURT HEREBY REQUESTS the aid and recognition of any court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body having jurisdiction in Canada to give effect to this Order. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders and to provide such assistance as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order.
