FIRST REPORT TO THE US COURT SUBMITTED BY FTI CONSULTING CANADA INC., IN ITS CAPACITY AS COURT-APPOINTED RECEIVER

FTI Consulting Canada Inc., Receiver herein, submits this status report to the Court in response to this Court's *Order for Status Report*, entered at Docket No. 43.

INTRODUCTION

- 1. On December 14, 2012 (the "Date of Appointment"), FTI Consulting Canada Inc. was appointed by the Supreme Court of British Columbia, Canada (the "Canadian Court") as receiver (the "Receiver") of all of the assets, undertakings and properties (the "Property") of Tercon Investments Ltd., Tercon A.C. Ltd., Tercon Equipment Ltd., Tercon Construction Ltd., Tercon Mining Ltd., Tercon Enterprises Ltd., Tercon MRC Limited, FNP Ventures Inc., Tercon Mining PV Ltd., Tercon Equipment Alaska Partnership and Tercon Alaska Ltd. (collectively, "Tercon" or the "Company") pursuant to the order of Mr. Justice Sewell (the "Receivership Order") granted upon the petition of Dumas Holdings Inc. ("DHI") pursuant to section 243(1) of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act R.S.C. 1985 c. B-3 as amended (the "BIA") and section 39 of the Law and Equity Act R.S.B.C 1996 c. 253, as amended.
- On January 17, 2013, the Receiver filed petitions in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Alaska (the "US Court") commencing proceedings (the "Ch. 15 Proceedings") under Chapter 15 of the United States Bankruptcy Code (the "USBC").
- 3. On February 19, 2013, the Honourable Judge Ross granted:
 - (i) An *Order Granting Recognition*, Docket No. 32, recognizing the Receivership as foreign main proceedings pursuant to Section 1517 of the USBC and ordering that all provisions of Section 1520 of the USBC apply in the Ch.15 Proceedings;
 - (ii) An Order Recognizing and Approving Approval and Vesting Order, Docket No. 33, approving the Approval and Vesting Order entered by the Canadian Court on January 15, 2013 which authorized the sale of the Tercon assets as described in more detail in paragraph 17 hereof; and

- (iii) An Order Recognizing and Approving Distribution Order, Docket No. 34, approving the Distribution Order entered by the Canadian Court on January 21, 2013 which established a regime for paying claims as described in more detail in paragraph 20 hereof.
- 4. For ease of reference, a copy of the docket for the Ch.15 Proceedings is attached hereto as Exhibit A. Copies of materials filed by the Receiver and various orders issued by the US Court are posted on the Receiver's website at http://cfcanada.fticonsulting.com/tercon (the "Receiver's Website").
- 5. To date, the Receiver has filed nine reports to the Canadian Court on various aspects of the Receivership. Each of the reports, and the orders made in the Receivership proceedings, are posted on the Receiver's Website. As the Receivership is the main proceeding, recognized pursuant to Orders issued in the Ch.15 Proceedings, separate reports have to date not been filed with the US Court.
- 6. On August 15, 2013, Judge Ross issued an *Order for Status Report*, Docket No. 43, instructing the Receiver to file a status report by August 30, 2013, advising the US Court:
 - (i) On the progress of the Ch.15 Proceedings as it relates to Alaskan property and activities;
 - (ii) About any anticipated activity in the US Court; and
 - (iii) Of the anticipated date when the Ch.15 Proceedings can be closed.
- 7. At Docket No. 44, the US Court extended the deadline for the filing of the Receiver's report to September 13, 2013.
- 8. This, the Receiver's First Report to the US Court, is provided in response to Docket No. 43.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 9. In preparing this report, the Receiver has relied upon unaudited financial information, other information available to the Receiver and, where appropriate, Tercon's books and records and discussions with various parties (collectively, the "**Information**").
- 10. Except as described in this Report:
 - (i) The Receiver has not audited, reviewed or otherwise attempted to verify the accuracy or completeness of the Information in a manner that would comply with Generally Accepted Assurance Standards pursuant to the Canadian Institute of Chartered Accountants Handbook or any US equivalent;
 - (ii) The Receiver has not examined or reviewed financial forecasts and projections referred to in this report in a manner that would comply with the procedures described in the Canadian Institute of Chartered Accountants Handbook or any US equivalent;
- 11. Future oriented financial information reported or relied on in preparing this report is based on assumptions regarding future events; actual results may vary from forecast and such variations may be material.
- 12. The Receiver has prepared this Report in response to Docket No. 43.
- 13. The information and advice described in this Report as being provided to the Receiver by its counsel, Borden Ladner Gervais LLP (the "Receiver's Canadian Counsel") and The Law Office of Cabot Christianson, P.C. (the "Receiver's US Counsel" and, together with Receiver's Canadian Counsel, the "Receiver's Counsel") has been provided to the Receiver to assist it in considering its course of action.
- 14. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined are as defined in the Receivership Order, other Orders granted in the Receivership Proceedings or in the Receiver's previous Reports.

ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS IN THE RECEIVERSHIP

- 15. Activities and events in the Receiverhip have been described in the Receiver's reports filed with the Canadian Court. As noted previously in this report, those reports are available on the Receiver's Website.
- 16. As described in the First Report, the Asset Purchase and Sale Agreement dated as of December 21, 2012, was entered into, subject to Court approval, between the Receiver as Vendor and Ritchie Bros. Auctioneers (Canada) Ltd. ("RB Canada") and Ritchie Bros. Auctioneers (America) Inc. ("RB America", RB Canada and RB America together being "Ritchie Bros") as Purchasers (the "APA") with respect to the Equipment and Miscellaneous Property of Tercon (as such terms are defined in the APA).
- 17. On January 15, 2013, Mr. Justice Sewell granted an Order (the "Approval and Vesting Order") *inter alia* approving the APA and the Return Protocol, as defined in the First Report. The transactions contemplated by the APA have been completed and all proceeds have been received.
- 18. All realizable assets have now been sold and substantially all accounts receivable owing to Tercon have been collected.
- 19. As described in the Receiver's Ninth Report, the following matters remain to be completed in the Receivership Proceedings:
 - (i) Filing of certain statutory returns and collection of sales tax refunds;
 - (ii) Agreement on terms of termination of the MoT contracts and conditions for release of the MoT Bonds;
 - (iii) Completion of matters relating to the AC&T Limited Partnership and Tahltan-Tercon Limited Partnership, non-filing debtors that are being administered by the Receiver pursuant to the terms of the Receivership Order, the partnership agreements and relevant management agreements;

- (iv) Final determination of certain claims pursuant to the Claims Procedure Order;
- (v) Distributions to creditors in accordance with their legal priorities; and
- (vi) Completion of Ch.15 Proceedings.
- 20. Pursuant to the Distribution Order granted January 21, 2013 by the Canadian Court, distributions have been made on account of certain valid and enforceable equipment and real property lien claims and on account of secured indebtedness owing to the Agent for the secured lenders.
- 21. The Ninth Report was filed by the Receiver in connection with a motion to be heard by the Canadian Court on September 12, 2013, in which the Receiver is seeking, amongst other things, authority to pay certain trust claims and certain employee claims.

ALASKAN PROPERTY AND ACTIVITIES

- 22. The tangible assets located in Alaska consisted of owned equipment and leased or rented equipment.
- 23. The owned equipment was sold to Ritchie Bros. pursuant to the APA and the Approval and Vesting Order, which Order was given full force and effect in the US by Docket No. 33. The sale of the owned assets located in Alaska was completed on February 22, 2013. In accordance with the provisions of the APA, Ritchie Bros. continued to occupy the site and conducted a public auction sale of the assets acquired on March 5, 2013. The site was vacated following the auction.
- 24. The Receiver negotiated the buy-out of certain leased equipment where the value of the equipment was greater than the buy-out owing. This equipment was also sold to Ritchie Bros.
- 25. All other leased and rented equipment located in Alaska and in the possession of the Receiver was released to the lease and rental companies.

- 26. A number of creditors submitted lien claims against the owned equipment, the Fort Knox mine (the real property of the account debtor where Tercon carried out work), or both. These lien claims were adjudicated in accordance with the provisions of the Claims Procedure Order entered by the Canadian Court. Four liens, held by North Central Rental & Leasing, LLC, Midstate Equipment, Inc., Stutzman Engineering Assn., Inc., and N. C. Machinery Co., were recorded against the Tercon assets located in Alaska and were determined to be valid and enforceable. Those lien claims were settled for the aggregate amount of US\$1,465,610.50, which was paid from the amounts realized by the Receiver.
- 27. The lien claim of Construction Machinery, Industrial, LLC ("CMI"), has been disallowed by the Receiver, and CMI has until September 10, 2013 to dispute the Receiver's adjudication of the claim. If the Receiver's adjudication is disputed, the claim will be adjudicated pursuant to the process set out in the Claims Procedure Order.
- 28. As previously reported by the Receiver, there will a shortfall on the claims of the secured creditors and, accordingly, there will be no distribution to unsecured creditors.
 Accordingly and as contemplated by the Claims Procedure Order, no adjudication has been made of claims ranking subordinate to the claims of the secured creditors.

ANTICIPATED ACTIVITY IN THE ALASKA BANKRUPTCY COURT

- 29. The only anticipated activity in the US Court are the following:
 - (i) Possible adjudication of the equipment liens claim held by CMI if it is determined that, for purposes of efficiency, the matter should be heard by the US Court rather than the Canadian Court which has jurisdiction over the Claims Procedure; and
 - (ii) Final motion for termination of the Ch.15 Proceedings.

ANTICIPATED DATE FOR CLOSURE OF THE CH.15 PROCEEDINGS

30. The Receiver anticipates filing a motion to terminate these Ch.15 Proceedings by December 31, 2013.
