SOLEMNLY AFFIRM THAT:

1. I am the Chief of West Moberly First Nations. As such, I have personal knowledge of the facts set out below, except where stated to be on information and belief, in which case I verily believe them to be true.
2. In my first affidavit I stated that the source of funds for the offers on the Wapiti and Bullmoose assets was a wholly Canadian source, further to an agreement which requires the West Moberly First Nations to maintain confidentiality.
