## NOTICE REGARDING HEARING ON SALE RECOGNITION MOTION

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that PT Holdco, Inc., PTUS, Inc. Primus Telecommunications, Inc., Lingo, Inc., and Primus Telecommunications Canada Inc. (collectively, the "Debtors") commenced insolvency proceedings in the Ontario Superior Court of Justice (Commercial List) in Toronto, Canada (the "Canadian Court") <sup>2</sup> (the "Canadian Proceeding") on January 19, 2016 for the purpose of approval of the sale of substantially all of the Debtors' assets (the "Sale").

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that an initial order was entered on January 19, 2016 in the Ontario Superior Court of Justice by the Honourable Mr. Justice Penny, Court File No. CV-16-11257-OOCL, In the Matter of a Plan of Compromise or Arrangement of PT Holdco, Inc., Primus Telecommunications Canada Inc., PTUS, Inc. Primus Telecommunications, Inc., and Lingo, Inc. ("Initial Order") [D.I. 3-1 at Exhibit A].

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that on January 19, 2016, FTI Consulting Canada Inc. ("Monitor" or "Foreign Representative"), the court-appointed monitor and duly authorized foreign representative for the Debtors filed the Verified Petition for Recognition of

The Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Bankruptcy Court") entered an Order Granting Provisional Relief Pursuant to Section 1519 of the Bankruptcy Code [D.I. 9] on January 21, 2016, a Second Order Granting Provisional Relief Pursuant to Section 1519 of the Bankruptcy Code [D.I. 20] on February 4, 2016, and the Order Granting Recognition and Related Relief [D.I. 32] was granted by the Bankruptcy Court on February 19, 2016.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that a hearing is scheduled for February 25, 2016 in the Ontario Superior Court of Justice (Commercial List) in Toronto, Canada for Sale approval.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that a hearing is scheduled for March 2, 2016 in the Ontario Superior Court of Justice (Commercial List) in Toronto, Canada regarding the assignment of contracts related to the Sale.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that all objections related to the Sale <u>must be</u> addressed in the <u>Ontario Superior Court of Justice (Commercial List) in Toronto, Canada</u>

Court File No. CV-16-11257-OOCL, In the Matter of a Plan of Compromise or Arrangement of PT Holdco, Inc., Primus Telecommunications Canada Inc., PTUS, Inc. Primus Telecommunications, Inc., and Lingo, Inc. Objections related to the Sale can be heard at the time of the February 25, 2016 and March 2, 2016 hearings in the Ontario Superior Court of Justice (Commercial List) in Toronto, Canada.

Market Street, Suite 1700, Wilmington, Delaware 19801 (Attention: Rafael X. Zahralddin, Esq.), United States counsel to the Monitor, so as to be received no later than 4:00 p.m. (Eastern Time) on February 24, 2016. [D.I. 24.]
