- 1. An Order, substantially in the form attached as **Schedule "A"**, ordering, *inter alia*:
  - (a) the approval of the Receiver's activities and the Receiver's interim statement of receipts and disbursements, as set forth in the Fourth Report of the Receiver dated August 12, 2022 (the "Fourth Report"); and
  - (b) the approval of second interim distributions, as described in the Fourth Report.

#### Grounds for making this application:

The grounds for making this application are set out more fully in the Fourth Report, but can be summarized as follows:

#### (A) Background

- 2. Any capitalized term not defined in the Application shall take the meaning ascribed to it in the Fourth Report.
- Pursuant to an Order of the Honourable Justice A.D. Grosse granted on March 11, 2022 (the "Receivership Order"), FTI Consulting Canada Inc. was appointed receiver of all of the assets, undertakings and properties (the "Property") of RBee Aggregate Consulting Ltd. (the "Debtor").
- 4. The Receivership Order empowers and authorizes, but does not obligate, the Receiver to, among other things, manage, operate and carry on the business of the Debtor and to take possession and control of the Property of the Debtor and any and all proceeds, receipts and disbursements arising out of or from the Property, and to sell, convey, transfer, lease or assign the Property or any part or parts thereof out of the ordinary course of business.
- 5. Pursuant to an Order of the Honourable Justice P.R. Jeffrey granted on July 11, 2022, the Receiver was authorized to make distributions to certain creditors of the Debtor.

### (B) Receiver's Activities and Accounts

6. The Receiver's actions and activities up to the date of this Application and the interim statement of receipts and disbursements for the period from March 11, 2022 to August 5, 2022, as described in the Fourth Report, are lawful, proper, and consistent with its powers under the Receivership Order.

7. It is appropriate that the second interim distributions be made to the creditors receiving those payments, as they are entitled to receive those payments in priority to other creditors.
