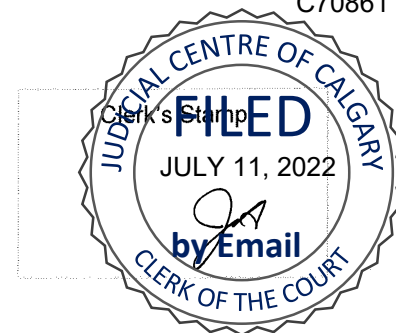

RECEIVER'S ACTIVITIES

1. The actions, conduct and activities of the Receiver, as described in the Third Report, are hereby authorized and approved.

INTERIM DISTRIBUTION

2. The Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to make interim distributions to the following parties and in substantially the following amounts:

GENERAL


6. All capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Third Report.
