Sale Solicitation Process

Current Situation

- On December 13, 2024, the Supreme Court of British Columbia granted an Order approving a sale solicitation process ("SSP") in the Receivership Proceedings of Rokstad Holdings Corporation, Rokstad Power (2018) Ltd., Golden Ears Painting & Sandblasting (2018) Ltd., Plowe Power Systems (2018) Ltd., Rokstad Power Construction Services Ltd., Rokstad Power Transmission Services Ltd., Rokstad Power (Prairies) Ltd., Rokstad Power (East), Inc., Rokstad Power Inc., and Rok Air LLC (collectively, "Rokstad").
- FTI Consulting Canada Inc., in its capacity as court appointed receiver (the "Receiver") is continuing Rokstad's operations and administering the SSP.
- The SSP is intended to solicit interest in, and opportunities for, a sale of all, or substantially all, of Rokstad's assets and business operations on a going concern basis.
- In conjunction with the SSP, the Receiver has entered into a stalking horse asset purchase agreement (the "Stalking Horse APA") with 1501841 B.C. Ltd. and Stellex Power Line Opco LLC., (the "Stalking Horse Bidder"), as purchaser. The Stalking Horse APA is intended to serve as a backstop to the SSP and set a floor price for the sale of Rokstad's business.
- The Stalking Horse Bidder is acquiring the assets and operations, on a going-concern basis, including certain assumed liabilities and contracts, employee benefits, contact cure amounts and other obligations described in the Stalking Horse APA. Timeline and Stalking Horse APA Information


- The SSP is an expedited 30-day process with a qualified bid deadline on January 10, 2025.
- Access to a virtual data room ("VDR") will require execution of a non-disclosure agreement ("NDA"). A template asset purchase agreement will be available in the VDR.
- The illustrative purchase price set out in the Stalking Horse APA is US\$44.7 million. The Stalking Horse APA includes the assumption of approximately 140 employees in Canada, 365 employees in U.S., and certain liabilities including but not limited to: obligations relating to assumed contracts, employee compensation and benefit plans, contract cure amounts and warranty obligations.
- The illustrative purchase price plus the assumed liabilities included in the Stalking Horse APA are collectively referred to as the "Illustrative Purchase Price". Pursuant to the SSP, the Receiver is seeking a 'Superior Offer', meaning a third party offer in excess of the Illustrative Purchase Price. The Stalking Horse APA contemplates an en bloc bid for Rokstad's business. However, interested parties can submit a bid for all of the business, or for the Canadian or US assets.
- Interested parties should contact the Receiver with respect to signing an NDA and/or access to the VDR. A bid instruction letter will be available in the VDR. Interest parties are asked not to contact Rokstad employees and management directly.


Company Snapshot and Acquisition Opportunity
