ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE J. DIETRICH:

- [1] This morning the Monitor filed its Third Supplement to the Fifth Report to Court dated December 4, 2025 (the "**Report**"). Defined terms used herein but not otherwise defined have the meaning provided for in the Report.
- [2] In that Report, the Monitor outlines a settlement which has been reached regarding, among other things, the TUV Motion which was scheduled to be heard today as well as with respect to a motion that was previously scheduled for February 12, 2026, regarding the ownership of Overseas.
- [3] The TUV Motion and Overseas ownership issue have now been resolved and the parties have submitted a consent order addressing the settlement.
- [4] Although the Report indicated a request to seal the Minutes of Settlement, the consent order has been amended to remove that relief.
- [5] Separately, counsel to the Purchaser has indicated that certain difficulties have been experienced registering on title the approval and vesting order granted on July 18, 2025. It may be that an amendment to that order will be sought. Counsel can arrange a case conference through the Commercial List Office in the normal course to address such relief.
- [6] The time reserved for February 12, 2026, has been vacated.
