**NOTICE OF INTERVENTION**

**TAKE NOTICE THAT** the Intervenors, Attorney General of Quebec and Retraite Québec, formerly named as Régie des rentes du Québec, in its capacity as the Québec Regulator of Pensions, intend to intervene and wish to be heard with respect to the within Reference proceeding (the “**Reference**”) pursuant to the Order of Green CJNL, which order was granted on an *ex parte* basis on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 2017.


**AND THAT** the grounds of this Intervention are:

1. THAT the Intervenor Retraite Québec acts as Pension Regulator in the Province of Québec and one of its functions is ensure that pension plans are administered and operated according to the *Supplemental Pension Plans Act* (QCS, c. R-15.1) for who employees who report for work at an establishment of their employer located in Québec, which is the case for the majority of members of the Salaried Plan concerned by this Reference.

2. THAT the Intervenor Retraite Québec is an impleaded party in proceedings pending before the Quebec Superior Court for the district of Montreal No 500-11-048114-157) (the "CCAA Proceedings) instituted pursuant to terms of the Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act, R.S.C., c. C-36, as amended (the "CCAA").
3. THAT the Intervenor, Attorney General of Quebec and Retraite Québec had been informed of the Notice of Intervention of Intervenor FTI Consultings Inc., signed on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 2017, and of its grounds for its Intervention.
4. THAT the Intervenor, Attorney General of Quebec and Retraite Québec, agree with and approves the grounds submitted in subsections 2 to 6 of the Intervenor FTI Consultings Inc.'s Notice of Intervention and intend to make submissions in support of such grounds at the hearing of the Reference.
