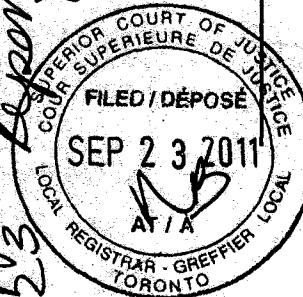

A stay extension to Dec 31, 2011, approval of the Monitor's 23 report + its fees + those of its counsel are requested. The rationale for the stay extension is in the 23 report. In essence, there is a need to attend to various matters including outstanding claims + the windup of certain subsidiaries.

Para 30 of the Monitor's report describes a 'monitor' claim. If this claim has not been resolved by Dec 9, 2011 + a further stay extension is required, counsel for the 'monitor' claim is to attend in court on a date to be arranged by the Monitor to address the reasons for the ongoing delay.

For the reasons set forth in paras 45 to 49 of the Monitor's report, I am granting the stay extension requested. The Plan Sponsor (Shaw) has received the proposed fees of the Monitor + its counsel + takes no issue with them. I am prepared to approve them - the circumstances. No one attended to oppose the approval of the fees or the 23 report + that relief requested. I have signed as well. I have signed the requested order.
