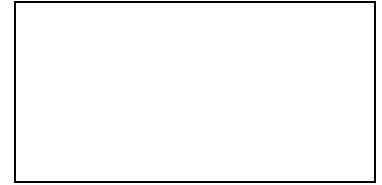

**NAME OF JUSTICE WHO MADE THIS ORDER:** The Honourable Mr. Justice K. Feth

**LOCATION OF HEARING:** Edmonton, Alberta (BY WEBEX)

**UPON** the application of **COALSPUR MINES (OPERATIONS) LTD.** (“Coalspur”); **AND UPON** having read the Seventh Affidavit of Michael Beyer, sworn November 29, 2021, including Confidential Exhibit “B” thereto (the “**Confidential Exhibit**”); **AND UPON** having read the Seventh Report of FTI Consulting Canada Inc. (the “**Monitor**”) in its role as Court-

appointed Monitor of Coalspur; **AND UPON** noting that when the application came before the Court on December 7, 2021, notice to the media had only been given by Coalspur one day prior and, as a result, this Interim Restricted Court Access Order was granted to provide sufficient time for notice to the media to be effected; **AND UPON** hearing from counsel for Coalspur, the Monitor, and any other counsel present; **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:**

1. Subject to further Order of this Honourable Court, the Confidential Exhibit shall be sealed on the Court file and shall not form part of the public record, notwithstanding Division 4, Part 6 of the *Alberta Rules of Court* until and including January 13, 2022.
2. Coalspur's application for a continuation of this Restricted Court Access Order sealing the Confidential Exhibit on the Court file beyond January 13, 2022 shall be heard by the Court on January 13, 2022.
3. The Clerk of this Honourable Court shall file the Confidential Exhibit in a sealed envelope attached to a notice that sets out the style of cause of these proceedings and states that:

THIS ENVELOPE CONTAINS CONFIDENTIAL MATERIALS FILED  
BY COALSPUR MINES (OPERATIONS) LTD. WHICH IS SEALED  
PURSUANT TO THE INTERIM RESTRICTED COURT ACCESS  
ORDER ISSUED BY MR. JUSTICE FETH ON DECEMBER 7, 2021.

4. Leave is hereby granted to any person, entity or party affected by this Interim Order to apply to this Court for a further Order vacating, substituting, modifying, or varying the terms of this Interim Order, with such application to be brought on notice to Coalspur and the Monitor.
