THIS MOTION, made by 15315441 Canada Inc. (the "Applicant") pursuant to the Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, as amended (the "CCAA") for an order (the "Order"), among other things: (a) approving the Fifth Report of FTI Consulting Canada Inc. ("FTI") in its capacity as monitor of the Applicant (in such capacity, the "Monitor") dated January 23, 2024 (the "Fifth Report"), the Sixth Report of the Monitor dated April 3, 2024 (the "Sixth Report"), the Seventh Report of the Monitor dated July 9, 2024 (the "Seventh Report", and together with the Fifth Report and the Sixth Report, the "Monitor's Reports") and the activities of the Monitor described therein; and (b) extending the Stay Period (as defined below), was heard this day by judicial videoconference via Zoom.

**ON READING** the Applicant's Notice of Motion dated July 8, 2024, the affidavit of Avininder Grewal sworn July 8, 2024 (the "**Grewal Affidavit**"), and the Exhibits thereto, the Monitor's Reports, and the appendices thereto, and on hearing the submissions of counsel for the Applicant, counsel for the Monitor, and such other parties as listed on the Participant Information Form, with no one else appearing although duly served as appears from the affidavit of service of Philip Yang, filed,

**SERVICE AND DEFINITIONS** 

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the time for service and filing of the Notice of Motion and the Motion Record is hereby abridged and validated so that this Motion is properly returnable today and hereby dispenses with further service thereof.

2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that capitalized terms used in this Order and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Grewal Affidavit and the Amended and Restated Initial Order issued by Justice Osborne on June 15, 2023 in this proceeding (the "**ARIO**").

APPROVAL OF THE MONITOR'S REPORTS AND ACTIVITIES

3. **THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES** that the Monitor's Reports and the activities of the Monitor referred to therein are hereby ratified and approved; provided, however, that only the Monitor, in its personal capacity and only with respect to its own liability, shall be entitled to rely upon or utilize in any way such approvals.

**EXTENSION OF THE STAY PERIOD** 

4. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Stay Period, as defined in the ARIO, is hereby extended until November 29, 2024.

**GENERAL** 

- 5. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Applicant or the Monitor may apply to the Court as necessary to seek further orders and directions to give effect to this Order.
- 6. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that this Order shall have full force and effect in all provinces and territories in Canada.
- 7. **THIS COURT HEREBY REQUESTS** the aid and recognition of any court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body having jurisdiction in Canada or in the United States, to give effect to this Order and to assist the Applicant, the Monitor and their respective agents in carrying out the terms of this Order. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders and to provide such assistance to the Applicant and to the Monitor, as an officer of this Court, as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order, to grant representative status to the Monitor in any foreign proceeding,

or to assist the Applicant and the Monitor and their respective agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.

- 8. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that this Order and all of its provisions are effective as of 12:01 a.m. Prevailing Eastern Time on the date hereof.
- 9. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that this Order is enforceable without the need for entry and filling.
