- 1. FTI Consulting Canada Inc., in its capacity as Court-appointed Monitor (in such capacity, the "Monitor") of Free Rein Resources Ltd. ("Free Rein"), seeks:
 - (a) an order substantially in the form attached hereto as <u>Schedule "B"</u>:
 - (i) if necessary, abridging the time for service of this application (the "Application") and the supporting Second Report of the Monitor, dated February 14, 2024 (the "Second Report") and declaring service to be good and sufficient;
 - (ii) approving and ratifying the actions, conduct and activities of the Proposal Trustee (as herein defined) as outlined in the First, Second, Third and Fourth Reports of the Proposal Trustee dated July 6, 2023, August 22, 2023, September 28, 2023 and November 17, 2023, respectively (collectively, the "NOI Reports") and filed in the NOI Proceedings (as herein defined);
 - (iii) approving and ratifying the actions, conduct and activities of the Monitor as outlined in the Pre-Filing, First and Second Reports of the Monitor dated December 6, 2023, January 17, 2024 and February 14, 2024, respectively (collectively, the "CCAA Reports") and filed in the within CCAA Proceedings (as herein defined); and

Grounds for making this application:

Background

- 3. On June 12, 2023, Free Rein filed a Notice of Intention to Make a Proposal (the "NOI") under subsection 50.4(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (Canada) ("BIA"). FTI Consulting Canada Inc. was appointed as proposal trustee (in such capacity, the "Proposal Trustee") in the NOI proceedings (the "NOI Proceedings") of Free Rein.
- 4. On December 7, 2023, Invico Income Limited Partnership, sought and obtained an initial order (the "Initial Order") and an amended and restated initial order (the "ARIO") granting, among other things, a continuation of Free Rein's NOI Proceedings under the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act* (Canada) (the "CCAA Proceedings").

Activities of the Proposal Trustee

- The Proposal Trustee's action, conduct and activities for the NOI Proceedings are described in the NOI Reports.
- 6. The Proposal Trustee's actions, conduct and activities are lawful, proper, and consistent with its powers under the BIA and orders issued by the Court in the NOI Proceedings.
