**UPON** the application of the Canadian Union of Public Employees ("CUPE"); AND UPON reading the Affidavit of Natasha Lisun sworn July 31, 2024: AND UPON hearing from counsel for CUPE, and counsel for FTI Consulting Canada Inc. (the "Monitor"), in its capacity as the court-appointed monitor of Lynx Air Holdings Corporation and 1263343 Alberta Inc. dba Lynx Air.

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:

## ORDER REGARDING THE EMPLOYEE DATA OF CABIN CREW EMPLOYEES

- 1. The Monitor shall provide the personal information (phone numbers, email addresses, and mailing addresses; the "Personal Information") in the Monitor's possession or control, of the members of CUPE Local 5558, to CUPE.
- 2. Pursuant to section 7(3)(c) of the *Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act*, S.C. 2000, c. 5, the Monitor is authorized and permitted to disclose the Personal Information of individuals who are believed to be members of CUPE Local 5558 to CUPE. CUPE shall maintain and protect the privacy of such information and shall limit the use of such information to its role as the bargaining agent of the Cabin Crew Employees. CUPE shall be entitled to continue to use the Personal Information provided to it, relating to the members of CUPE Local 5558, in a manner which is in all material respects identical to the prior use of such information by the Monitor.

3. The balance of CUPE's Application for it to be appointed the Representative of the Cabin Crew Employees pursuant to Rule 2.16 of the *Alberta Rules of Court*, Alta. Reg. 124/2010, is dismissed.
