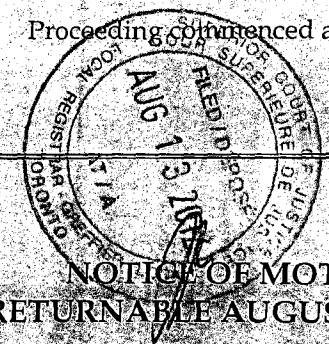
This matter is not opposed. The

to the order now agreed.

The officers and directors of the Timminco
entities have resigned. In the circumstances,
the appointment of the CRO is reasonable,
if not entirely necessary for the sake of
all stakeholders, including the Ministry
of the Environment. The protections provided
in the order for the CRO are also reasonable
and necessary. Without them, no one
could realistically agree to be appointed
a CRO.
