UPON THE APPLICATION of by FTI Consulting Canda Inc. in its capacity as Court-appointed receiver (the "**Receiver**") of the undertaking, property, and assets of RBee Aggregate Consulting Ltd. ("**RBee**") for an order directing RMC Construction Materials Inc. ("**RMC**") to pay to the Receiver certain amounts claimed by the Receiver to be due, owing, and payable by RMC to RBee;

AND UPON having read the Fifth Report of the Receiver dated October 28, 2022 (the "**Fifth Report**") and the Supplemental Report to the Fifth Report dated January 20, 2023;

AND UPON having read the affidavits of Nicolas Burak sworn December 23, 2022, and January 28, 2023, as well as the affidavit of Scott Marshall sworn December 16, 2022;

AND UPON having read the briefs of the Receiver dated February 26, March 12, April 1, and April 8, 2026 and the briefs of RMC dated March 6, April 1, and April 8, 2026;

AND UPON hearing the submissions of counsel for the Receiver, and counsel for RMC on March 18, 2026;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Capitalized terms used herein and not otherwise defined have the meanings given to them in the decision of the Honourable Justice C.D. Simard, dated August 7, 2026 and bearing the neutral citation 2026 ABKB 561.
2. RMC must pay the following amounts to the Receiver:
 - (a) The sum of \$3,663,496.50, plus \$183,174.83 (GST) and interest for delivered Product;
 - (b) The sum of \$469,687.28, plus \$23,484.36 (GST) and interest for hauling charges;
 - (c) The interest provided for herein under sub-paragraphs 2(a) and (b) shall be simple interest at the contractual rate of 12% per annum, starting to accrue 60 days after the issuance of each Unpaid Invoice to which the sums set out in sub-paragraphs 2(a) and (b) herein relate.
3. If the parties cannot agree on costs, the Receiver and RMC may make written submissions within 45 days from August 7, 2026, limited to five pages each, excluding attachments.
